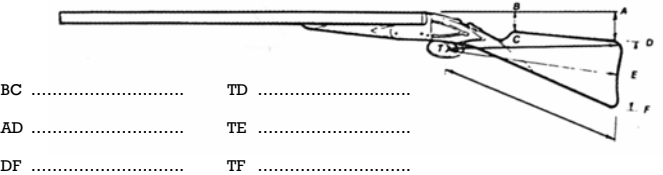
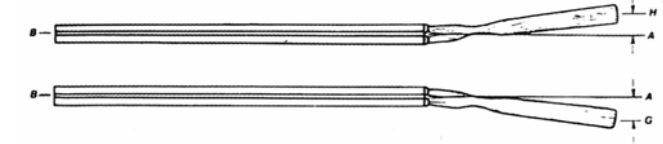


Gunfitting

STOCK MEASUREMENTS: How 'bend' and 'length' in a gun stock are measured. AB is the continuation of the straight line of the top of the barrels. C is the 'comb', D the 'heel', F the 'toe' and E the centre of the butt. T is the middle of the front trigger. Bend is given by the two measurements BC and AD. Length is given by the three measurements TD, TE, TF. The measurement DF is the depth of toe to heel.



CAST OFF/ON MEASUREMENTS: AB is the continuation of the straight line between the barrels. G and H are the centre of the heel of the stock. AH cast off for a gentlemen or lady who shoots from right shoulder. AG cast off for a gentlemen or lady who shoots from left shoulder.

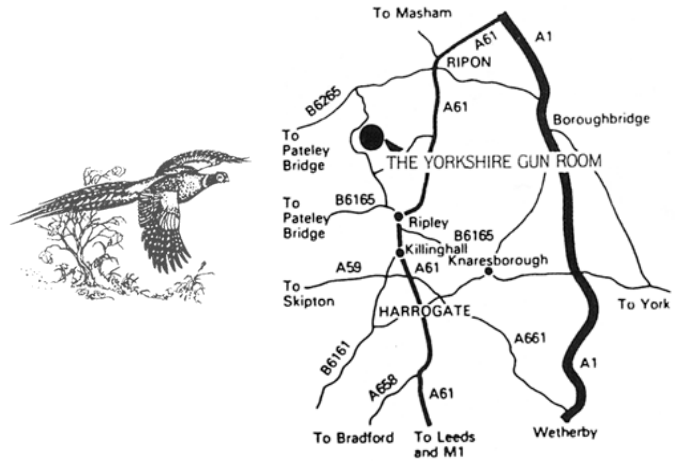

Over the last few years our Company Clay Days have become an extremely successful form of entertainment for companies to invite their clients and business associates for either a full or half day clay pigeon shooting.

The emphasis on a professionally run day, held in an informal atmosphere which helps to make a very enjoyable experience for everyone.

All our equipment is the most up-to-date on the market: automatic clay traps, guns, cartridges specially loaded for minimum recoil, ear protection — all inclusive.



Format of a Company Clay Day

- Meet at the shooting ground and coffee will be served.
- Informal introduction to the coaches, safety aspects and general talk on day's proceedings.
- Shooting starts with individual tuition over a number of different stands. During the event there will be a short break for drinks, etc.
- After the break we will reform for a team event which will be a set number of targets over the stands.
Note: again the coaches will be on hand if anyone needs further instruction.
- Back to the Gun Room for any prize giving.



Shooting Ground

On our grounds we have individual lessons and private tuition specializing in driven game shooting; we have clay targets to replicate grouse, pheasants and partridge. Each layout is set in a realistic landscape with grouse coming in below the butts eye level, partridges over hedges and pheasants over trees to 120ft and standard and midi clays from specially designed remote controlled traps.

We can take groups of 5-50 people who can shoot round our novice/starter layout with expert tuition and safety given by our instructors. Field instruction is also available for shoot days.
